	again urged to report the issues; there is evidence to suggest that action is more likely to	
	be taken if a significant number of complaints are registered and claims for repairs are	
	made.	
	Speed Signs: The advisory speed signs have just arrived. There is now a need to identify	
	where they are best positioned. John Acres suggested that one could be placed at each	
	entry point to the village, leaving the other 2 for points where it is particularly dangerous.
